WHERE ARE WE AT?

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT IN THE PROJET

PRESENTATIONS

- More than 50 organizations working with people between the ages of 12 and 25 were approached to raise awareness for the project and to propose participation in Aire ouverte work. We are continuing with our presentations.
- More than 60 internal and external partners are involved in the project. The project was presented to the local organizational coordination committees (CCOL) in the region in order to include the entire Outaouais region in our thought process. Efforts are ongoing.
- An initial presentation was made to the Regional MSSS-MEQ Committee (Ministère de santé et services sociaux – Ministère de l'éducation) and status reports are being provided to the regional and local committees.

COLLECTIVE DIALOGUES

To allow all those involved with 12 to 25-year-olds to share their views and ideas in building the service, we have created these collaborative spaces for external partners. During these events, we invite you to discuss various themes. For each theme, we explore the needs of youth and care providers, existing services, missing services and possible solutions.

WORK HAS BEGUN!

Community, cross-sectoral and internal partners of the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux de l'Outaouais (CISSS) are currently working on a preliminary version of the offer of service that will evolve over time according to the needs of the population and the contribution of the various communities to build an Aire ouverte that aligns with the current service offering for our youth.

We are currently in the process of gathering information on the needs and we will begin the analysis shortly. We would like to acknowledge the support of the specialized nurse practitioner team (SNP) at the CISSS de l'Outaouais as well as Dr. Ann-Stéphan Foccroulle in the development of the medical component.

AIRE OUVERTE WEB PAGE

To keep you informed on the project's progress in the region, a web page will be included on the CISSS de l'Outaouais site in the coming weeks. Since the summer of 2021, with the collaboration of youth and partners, Natasha, Josiane and Emilie have been working to develop an Aire ouverte within the CISSS de l'Outaouais, under the direction of Youth Programs.

The project is based on citizen participation that puts youth and their loved ones at the centre of decisions. Youth engagement is central to the creation of Aire ouverte services.

YOUTH COMMITTEE

On January 27, the first meeting of the Aire ouverte youth committees took place.

More than 10 members from all walks of life meet regularly to share their ideas and recommendations on the work being done by Aire ouverte.

We also have youth partners who accompany us in our work.

CONSULTATION

In order to meet the needs of youth, we meet with them to discuss their reality. To reach a larger number of teenagers and young adults, a survey on their health and social services needs has been circulating since December 28.

A special **THANK YOU** to all the people who worked hard to get the survey out. To date, your support has yielded over **1000 responses!**

Youth and parents from across the Outaouais region have participated:

The majority of respondents reside in the RLS of Grande-Rivière-Hull-Gatineau, while 25% of respondents come from the surrounding RLS (local service network).

We continue to survey youth and their parents to get the most accurate picture of their needs.
